

## **PASSPORT REQUIREMENT**

Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your date of entry into Israel and/or Jordan and you must have a round trip ticket.

## **VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR ISRAEL AND JORDAN**

Nationals of the following countries do not need to obtain an entry permit or visa prior to their arrival in Israel; they automatically receive a Tourist Visa, valid for three months, upon entering the country: Albania, Andorra, Argentina, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Belarus, Belize, Botswana, Brazil, Canada, Central Africa Republic, Chile, Columbia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Eswatini, European Union Member Countries, Federated States of Micronesia, Fiji Islands, Georgia, Germany (persons born after 1.1.1928), Grenada, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Hong Kong, Iceland, Jamaica, Japan, Lesotho, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Macao, Malawi, Mauritius, Mexico, Moldova (biometric passport holders only), North Macedonia, Norway, Monaco, Mongolia, Montenegro, Nauru, New Zealand, Norway, Palau, Panama, Papua New Guinea, Paraguay, Peru, Philippines, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, San Marino, Serbia, Singapore, Solomon Islands, South Africa, South Korea, Suriname, Switzerland, Taiwan, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Ukraine, Uruguay, United Kingdom, United States, Vanuatu, and Vatican City.

If you are a national of a country **not** on this list, contact the Director of Historical Geography Programs, Dr. Ginger Caessens (caessens@aol.com), for advice before submitting your application. You will need to secure a visa in advance of your entry. The application process can take several months and Israel may not approve visas for nationals from certain countries.

A group visa, free of charge, is issued for most students traveling overland to Jordan from Israel with the University of the Holy Land. If you are flying directly into Jordan, you will have to purchase a visa at the airport. However, if you are not a citizen of the U.K., U.S., Canada, or a Western European country, let our office know as soon as possible. It might be necessary for you to secure a personal visa in advance whether entering Jordan overland or by air. As is the case with Israel, the process might take several months and Jordan might not approve visas for nationals from certain countries.
